What LPCF are NOT?

- ⇒ A campaign / protest group (charity / grant conditions forbid this).
- ⇒ An advocacy service working on individual cases (though LPCF absolutely do want to hear your experiences and can raise those issues with providers of services).
- ⇒ In the pocket of the Local Authority or Health (LPCF are fiercely independent).
- ⇒ A designated support group (Although LPCF do provide lots of signposting / workshops and bring people together to network and learn.)
- ⇒ A formal or informal information or advice service (check out the LCC Local offer and Liaise who provide free legal advice to Lincs parents around Education and SEND).




