## **Response from Children & Young People Programme Manager -NHS Lincolnshire Integrated Care Board**

In response to child epilepsy service in Lincolnshire – ULHT have a consultant general paediatrician who has a special interest in epilepsy and have just appointed 2 new epilepsy specialist nurses. This means they are able to look after children with non -complex and well controlled epilepsy but depending on the child's condition they may be seen by a specialist paediatric neurologist at Nottingham rather than at Lincoln or Boston. Around 50% of children & young people with epilepsy need to be under the care of a paediatric neurologist, usually Nottingham but some may go to Sheffield (or other tertiary centre). We are currently working with UHLT and Nottingham to see if outreach clinics can be held, where a Nottingham consultant will come over to Lincoln.
