

Transforming Care – LPFT Services

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What is the Transforming Care Agenda?

- Winterbourne View and other enquiries led to cross-government commitment to transform care and support for people with a learning disability and/or autism
- Term Learning Disability and Autism Programme likely to be used going forwards
- Including those who display behaviour that challenges and/or can lead to contact with the criminal justice system
- Increase Community Capacity and Community Care
- Reduce Inappropriate Hospital Admissions
- Care Closer to Home
- Right Care, Right Place, Right Time
- 'No Wrong Door'
- 'Building the Right Support' in Long Term Plan

Practical Aspects of Transforming Care

- Transforming Care Partnership Register – All Age
 - NHSE held register of those in mental health/specialist hospital settings with autism/intellectual disability diagnosis
- Dynamic Support Register (DSR) – All Age
 - DSR is the tool used in a local area to identify individual children, young people and adults with a learning disability, autism or both who are at risk or may become at risk of admission to a mental health inpatient setting without specific and timely Dynamic Support
 - Integrated Care Board oversight but managed by LPFT
 - Regular DSR meetings (weekly in adults, fortnightly in children)



Autism Programme Lead (Lincs ICS)

- 18mth secondment to lead system partners to review and improve the Lincolnshire offer to our Autistic and wider Autism Community (finishes in Sept/Oct next year)
- Feed into the Lincolnshire Autism Partnership Board and advocate for the autism support and services in other system wide meetings e.g. MHLDA alliance, CYP transformation board



Current Workstreams

- Neurodevelopmental Pathway review – current gaps in services and review of existing offer
- Development community support offer – Lincolnshire Virtual Autism Hub
- Rewrite of the Lincolnshire Autism Strategy
- Development of an Autistic Adult Forum
- Sensory processing community pathway bid



Community Support – Virtual Autism Hub

- 3 phases across 5 years
- Likely to be run through local statutory organisation in first year – aim to move to become independent in years 2 onwards
- Steering Group
- Autism Care Navigation
- Autistic Autism Forum
- Promoting employment for Autistic people
- Ongoing development of the local offer: new groups within local communities, training, Lincolnshire Autism Reasonable Adjustment Mark, development of physical spaces



CYP LDA Keyworker Team

- Currently being established – just recruited team co-ordinator and lead keyworker
- 0-25 LDA cohort who are at high risk of admission to hospital
- Starting with 11-20yrs, will increase once team fully established
- Service accessed when CYP is amber, red or blue (inpatient) on DSR
- To support the CYP, families and carers, with a keyworker who can help co-ordinate other services and advocate



Keyworker Service

The service

- Based within LPFT - Independent team.
- Aim it to support 0-25 year olds Autistic or those with Learning who are at high risk of admission to mental health inpatient facility.
- Initially working with 11-20yrs and hoping to expand to 0-25 from beginning of Sept.
- Amber, Red or Blue on DSR
- Our aim is to support Children, Young People and their families/carers through the processes and systems in place but also to live a full and happy life.
- We will always focus on a CYPs aspirations and work towards these!
