# What do CAMHS LD do?

- A community-based team offering specialist support to children and young people aged between 0-18 years who have a moderate to severe learning disability
- Specialist support to those experiencing significant mental health problems.
- Work closely with universal services such as Paediatrics, GP's, Social Care, and early help to provide collaborative support
- Do not provide support with physical health
- Do not provide a learning disability diagnostic service

# What do Adult LD do?

- A community-based team offering specialist support to adults who due to the nature of their learning disability are unable to access mainstreams despite reasonable adjustments being made
- Specialist support to those who have significant mental health needs, behaviours of concern, nutrition and swallowing, mobility, movement and postural care and a liaison service for primary and acute physical health care
- Work closely with Adult social care services
- Do not provide a learning disability diagnostic service
