SEND Adult Cricket for 12 years of age upwards

The aim of playing hardball competitive cricket against other SEND teams within and close to Lincolnshire.

The sessions will be designed to help both the experienced hardball cricketer and someone new to cricket.

Qualified and DBS cleared coaches will be there. All kit is provided.

The Saturdays started on 1 February and run to 5 April 2025 - 11.30 to 12.30pm and they are free of charge.

Held in the Sports Hall, Priory Lincoln Academy, Skellingthorpe Road, Lincoln LN6 0EP

Softball cricket for Primary school age for SEN children - boys and girls from 5 - 11 years of age.

It's on Thursdays 5.30pm - 6.30pm at the Moorland Community Centre, Moorland Avenue, Lincoln LN6 7NH.

It's free of charge right through to the end of March 2025.

Asked about the sessions Ian Dovey Level 2 coach at HCC said:

“We are proud at the club that we have so many youngsters playing the game . They are the future of the club.

Last summer we had 142 boys and girls under 15 playing at our ground; 46 of whom were girls.

We do have some SEN children who play but we felt it would a good idea to have SEN only sessions all year round - ie indoors in the Winter and outdoor at our ground in the summer.

We simply think everyone should play cricket and want to make it as accessible as possible!

Then Lincolnshire Cricket Board came up with the idea of an Adult SEND team representing the club and coaching adults with a view to playing for a Lincs Disability Team.”
